Food Pantry: Our food pantry is open on *Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10-noon*. If you or someone you know could benefit, please come! And get the word out! A HUGE thank you to Kieth Murphy, Duane Garbrecht, Fred Schrank and Mary Beyer for helping get the shelves re-stocked.

Plans to Reopen Church for Worship: Our first Worship will be on *May 31. Service times - 8am, 10am, and 1pm*. With social distancing, we can have at least 64 people in the sanctuary at the same time if we include the balcony Pastor and Lynn will be calling people to sign up. We will not have Communion at the first service, but when we do: We'll post information on website trinitymarinette.com/events, Facebook, twitter and Instagram, it will also be included in our bulletin, and Pastor will announce it online after services

Disinfection process

- The elements would be available on the communion rail on disposable plates and disposable cups (no common cup). After consecrating the elements, I would call the communicants up one family at a time to pick up the elements When everybody has returned to their places with the elements, I would instruct them to eat and drink.
- Remove hymnals from pews
- Remove children's bags
- Remove pens
- We're not going to pass plates – put offerings into boxes in entry on the way in or out
- Pews, door handles, rails wiped down after each service
- People sit in every other pew
- Bulletins will be on a table for pick up
- Worship folders
- Announcement sheets
- No connection cards
- Hearing aids will be disinfected after each service

Recommend wearing a mask, although it won't be required (Ushers will wear a mask and hand sanitizer will be available in the building. If you're not feeling well or any flu symptoms, please wait until next week (on slide and in communications)

- If you're at risk, we recommend you wait until the pandemic trends down
