Face Mask Requirements – We have the opportunity to obey both the Third and Fourth Commandments as we worship. Our governor in Wisconsin has issued an edict that requires us to wear masks in church. So bring a mask. If you don't have a mask with you, we will be happy to provide one for you! There are exceptions to the rule.

1. Infants and children ages 2-5 don't have to wear a mask (although they do recommend it).
2. Individuals who have trouble breathing don't have to wear a mask.
3. When a single individual is giving a religious presentation for an audience, the single speaker may remove the face covering when actively speaking. While the face covering is removed, the speaker must remain at least 6 feet away from all other individuals at all times.

(There is also an exception for people who are sleeping, but I'm hoping that won't be common in worship.)
