1. Write all the Old Testament Books of the Bible.

Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy, Joshua, Judges, Ruth, 1st and 2nd Samuel, 1st and 2nd Kings, 1st and 2nd Chronicles, Ezra, Nehemiah, Esther, Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Song of Songs (Song of Solomon), Isaiah, Jeremiah, Lamentations, Ezekiel, Daniel, Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, Malachi.

2. The Second Commandment.

You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not use His name to curse, swear, lie or deceive, or use witchcraft, but call upon God's name in every trouble, pray, praise and give thanks.

3. *Passage* - Why did God reveal his name to us?

Romans 10:13 Yes, "Everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved."

Psalms 50:15 Call on me in the day of distress. I will deliver you, and you will honor me.

Psalms 22:22 I will declare your name to my brothers. In the midst of the congregation I will praise you.

- a. God gives us his name so we can be saved in it.
- b. God gives us his name so we can call to him when we need help.
- c. God gives us his name so we can tell people about him.
- d. God gives us his name so we can praise him.

4. How do we misuse God's name?

James 3:10 Blessing and cursing come out of the same mouth. My brothers, these things should not be this way.

- a. We misuse God's name by cursing.

James 5:12 Above all, my brothers, do not swear—not by heaven or by earth or by anything else. Just let your "yes" be "yes" and your "no" be "no," so that you do not fall under judgment.

- b. We misuse God's name by swearing

Matthew 7:15 Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves.

- c. We misuse God's name by lying about God's Word

Matthew 15:7-8 Hypocrites! Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you: These people honor me with their lips, but their heart is far from me.

- d. We misuse God's name by deceiving (hypocrisy).

Deuteronomy 18:10-12 Let no one be found among you who makes his son or his daughter pass through fire, or who uses divination, or who engages in fortune telling, or who observes omens, or who practices witchcraft, or who casts a magic spell, or who consults a ghost or a familiar spirit, or who inquires of the dead. Anyone doing these things is detestable to the LORD, and because of these abominations, the LORD your God is driving them out before you..

- e. We misuse God's name by practicing witchcraft, the occult, or superstition.

5. How do we sometimes dishonor God's name by our *failure* to use it?

1 Thessalonians 5:17 - Pray without ceasing.

- a. Sometimes we don't pray.

Isaiah 43:21 - This people that I formed for myself will declare my praise.

- b. Sometimes we don't praise him.

Psalm 105:1 - Give thanks to the LORD. Proclaim his name. Make his deeds known among the peoples.

- c. Sometimes we don't thank him.

6. How do we know that our sins against the second commandment are forgiven?

2 Corinthians 5:21 God made him, who did not know sin, to become sin for us, so that we might become the righteousness of God in him..

Jesus took our sins upon himself and died to pay for them. He gave us his perfect righteousness as a gift of grace.

7. What does God's Word tell us to do to keep the second commandment?

Psalm 50:15 Call on me in the day of distress. I will deliver you, and you will honor me.

1 Thessalonians 5:17 Pray without ceasing.

Psalm 52:9 I will thank you forever because you have done this. I will hope in your name in the presence of your favored ones because it is good.

Ephesians 5:18-20 And do not get drunk on wine, which causes you to lose control. Instead, be filled with the Spirit by speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs (singing and making music with your hearts to the Lord), by always giving thanks for everything to God the Father, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,

Acts 4:20 For we cannot stop speaking about what we have seen and heard.

Matthew 28:19-20 Therefore go and gather disciples from all nations by baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and by teaching them to keep all the instructions I have given you. And surely I am with you always until the end of the age.

God tells us to

- a. Pray
- b. Praise him
- c. Give thanks to him
- d. Tell people about him
- e. Teach people his Word.

8th Grade - The Second Article up to "What does this mean?"

I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord; who was conceived by the Holy Spirit; born of the Virgin Mary; suffered under Pontius Pilate; was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead.
