Old Testament Lesson

Christmas has passed for another year. I wonder how many people missed it. For some, the expectation of joy is over. For others, the pressure is gone. Some will remember time with family and friends. Others will remember time without them. Far too few will share our lasting joy of God's love. Jesus came to us. God is still with us. He enfolds us in grace and mercy.

Epistle Lesson

The noise of the world's Christmas is passing away. The joy of our Christmas is just beginning. The gifts God has given us live in our hearts and enrich our lives. God's gifts bring us peace and delight. They change us. They make us more like Jesus.

Think about the gifts God lists in Colossians 3: heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. Priceless gifts from our heavenly Father.

Now we get to use them, to make our lives a little better, to share the love of God, and glorify him with lives of thanks. We offer forgiveness. We live in love. The peace of Christ directs our hearts.

Let's let the word of Christ dwell in us richly. Let's teach and admonish. Let's sing and give thanks together. Let's do everything in the name of Jesus. He came to us on Christmas. He stays with us forever.

Colossians 3:12-17(EHV)

¹² Therefore, as God's elect, holy and loved, clothe yourselves with heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. ¹³ Bear with one another and forgive each other if anyone has a complaint against anyone else. Forgive, just as Christ forgave you. ¹⁴ And, in addition to all these things, put on love, which ties things together in perfect unity. ¹⁵ Let

the peace of Christ control your hearts, to which you were also called, in one body. And be thankful.

¹⁶ Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, with gratitude in your hearts to God. ¹⁷ And everything you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

Gospel Lesson/Sermon Text:

Did you ever wonder how many people realized who it was who came to the temple that day? Most people just passed by a peasant couple carrying a baby. But two people knew. God revealed himself to Simeon and Anna. And they praised God and gave him thanks. They sang and they rejoiced. How could they not? God was right there, fulfilling promises and bringing redemption. They kept telling people about the child to anyone who would listen.

Now God has revealed himself to me! If he had he revealed himself to anyone else, I could understand that; but he has revealed and given himself to me, the most unworthy of people. That I will never understand; but I will receive him and sing his praises to all who will listen.

He comes to you today in Word and Sacrament. How many people miss that?

God has revealed himself to us. Let us praise him and give him thanks. Let's sing and rejoice. How can we not? God is here. Let's share the joy and tell everyone who will hear us.

Luke 2:25-40 (EHV)

- ²⁵ Now there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon. This man was righteous and devout, waiting for the comfort of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was on him. ²⁶ It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ. ²⁷ Moved by the Spirit he went into the temple courts. When the parents brought in the child Jesus to do for him what was customary according to the law, 28 Simeon took him into his arms and praised God. He said,
- ²⁹Lord, you now dismiss your servant in peace, according to your word,
 - ³⁰ because my eyes have seen your salvation,
 - ³¹ which you have prepared before the face of all people,
- ³² a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of your people Israel.
- 33 Joseph and the child's mother were amazed at the things that were spoken about him. 34 Then Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, "Listen carefully, this child is appointed for the falling and rising of many in Israel and for a sign that is spoken against, 35 so that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed. And a sword will pierce your own soul too."
- ³⁶ Anna, a prophetess, was there. She was a daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was very old. She had lived with her husband for seven years after her marriage,³⁷ and then she was a widow of eighty-four years. She did not leave the temple complex, since she was worshipping with fasting and prayers night and day. ³⁸ Standing nearby at that very

hour, she gave thanks to the Lord. She kept speaking about the child to all who were waiting for the redemption of Jerusalem.

³⁹ When they had accomplished everything according to the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own town, Nazareth. ⁴⁰ The child grew and became strong. He was filled with wisdom, and God's favor was on him.
