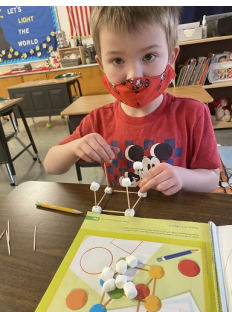

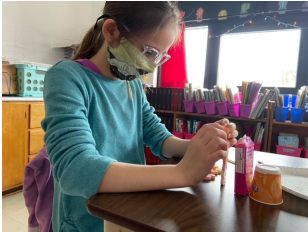

### 5th - 8th Grades - Mr. Danell & Mrs. Kamps

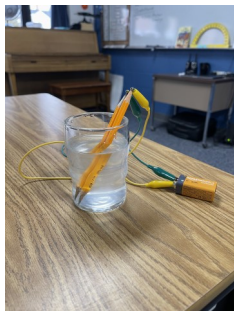
Greetings!

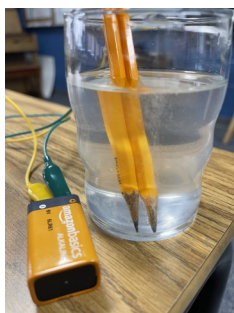

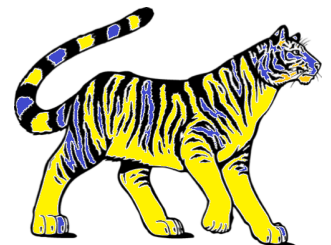
