## **Old Testament Lesson**

*Our readings today illustrate passing faith from generation to generation. Old Testament lesson shows how much Moses loved God's people. When his time was coming to an end, his prayer was that God would send someone to lead the people when he was gone. It is not Moses who was indispensable, but God and his gracious presence in the Word. With God, the Israelites would succeed. They needed a leader to keep them connected to God.*

*Whether it's through a parent, a pastor, a teacher, or anyone else that loves us, every generation needs leaders who will share the Word of God and keep people connected to Jesus.*

### **Numbers 27:12-23 (EHV)**

<sup>12</sup> The LORD said to Moses, "Go up onto this mountain in the Abarim range and see the land which I have given to the Israelites. <sup>13</sup> After you have seen it, you yourself will also be gathered to your people just as Aaron your brother was gathered. <sup>14</sup> For when the community quarreled in the Wilderness of Zin, you both rebelled against my command to honor me as holy in their sight at the waters." (This refers to the waters of Meribah Kadesh in the Wilderness of Zin.)

<sup>15</sup> Moses spoke to the LORD, <sup>16</sup> "May the LORD, the God of the spirits of all flesh, appoint a man over the community, <sup>17</sup> who will go out before them and come in before them, who will lead them out and bring them in, so that the community of the LORD will not be like sheep without a shepherd."

<sup>18</sup> The LORD said to Moses, "Take Joshua son of Nun, a man in whom is the Spirit, and place your hand on him. <sup>19</sup> Have him stand in front of Eleazar the priest and the entire community. You will commission him in their sight. <sup>20</sup> You will give some of your authority to him so that the entire Israelite community will listen to him. <sup>21</sup> He will stand before Eleazar the priest, who will inquire for him before the LORD with the decision of the

Urim. He and all the Israelites with him, the entire community, will go out at his command and come in at his command.”

<sup>22</sup> Moses did just as the LORD commanded him. He took Joshua and had him stand in front of Eleazar the priest and the entire community. <sup>23</sup> He placed his hands on him and commissioned him, just as the LORD spoke through Moses.

### **Epistle Lesson**

*Our epistle lesson teaches us the proper response to people who speak the Word. Remember that God gives life and salvation through the Word. So, he tells us to imitate their faith, obey them, and pray for them.*

*The only hope people have in this sinful world is the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Let work together with and support those who bring the Word to the world. God works among us to equip us to carry out his work. To him be glory forever and ever!*

### **Hebrews 13:7-8, 17-21 (EHV)**

<sup>7</sup> Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to you. Carefully consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith. <sup>8</sup> Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

<sup>17</sup> Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls as men who will give an account. Obey them, so that they may do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no benefit to you.

<sup>18</sup> Pray for us, because we are sure that we have a good conscience, and because in everything we want to conduct ourselves in an honorable way. <sup>19</sup> I urge you to do this even more, so that I may be restored to you quickly.

<sup>20</sup> Now may the God of peace—who brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, in connection with his blood, which established the eternal testament <sup>21</sup> may he equip you with every good thing to do his will, as he works in us what is pleasing in his sight through Jesus Christ. To him be glory forever and ever. Amen.

### **Gospel Lesson & Sermon**

*The Gospel lesson illustrates the excitement of sharing God's word and the importance of remaining in it. It also reveals the reason that we pass the Gospel on to each new generation. Jesus heart went out to people who didn't know their Good Shepherd. He taught them what they needed to know. Now Jesus has given us that privilege.*

*We carry the Word of Life among people who need a Savior. Our hearts go out to people. Let's invite them to go to a quiet place with Jesus to find rest for their weary souls.*

### **Mark 6:30-34 (EHV)**

<sup>30</sup> The apostles gathered around Jesus and reported to him all that they had done and taught. <sup>31</sup> He said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a secluded place and rest a while." For there were so many people coming and going that they did not even have a chance to eat. <sup>32</sup> They went away in the boat to a deserted place by themselves. <sup>33</sup> But many people saw them leave and knew where they were going. They ran there on foot from all the towns and arrived ahead of them. <sup>34</sup> When Jesus stepped out of the boat, he saw a large crowd. His heart went out to them because they were like sheep without a shepherd. He began to teach them many things.
