Epistle Lesson

By the standard of the world, Moses was a fool. He gave up a life of luxury and power. He could have been a prince in Egypt! He chose to be mistreated with God's people instead. To be part of the rich and the elite, he would have had to live in their sinful ways. He rejected sin and followed God instead.

Moses lived by faith. He listened to God. He believed that eternal life was worth more than the temporary treasures of Egypt. When the angel of death arrived, Moses believed God's promises in the Passover. He, his family, and everyone who believed in the Word of God were spared and given freedom from slavery and eternal life.

Hebrews 11:24–28 (EHV)

²⁴By faith Moses refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter when he grew up. ²⁵He chose to be mistreated with God's people rather than enjoy sin for a little while. ²⁶He considered disgrace for the sake of Christ as greater wealth than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward.

²⁷By faith he left Egypt without fearing the king's wrath, because he persevered as one who sees him who is invisible.

²⁸By faith he celebrated the Passover and the sprinkling of blood, so that the destroyer of the firstborn would not strike them down.

Gospel Lesson

Our Gospel lesson shows us that the Bible can be offensive to unbelieving hearts; we see it all the time. Yet God's Word is life. The best human wisdom can offer is temporary. Only God can give eternal life.

Still, it takes a miracle to overcome the unbelief in our hearts. Many people walk away from God rather than face the truth. How many times in your life have you been tempted to ignore God to follow your own wisdom? How many times have you actually done it?

We pray that we follow Jesus by faith, responding with Peter, "You have the words of eternal life!"

John 6:60-69 (EHV)

⁶⁰When they heard it, many of his disciples said, "This is a hard teaching! Who can listen to it?"

⁶¹But Jesus, knowing in himself that his disciples were grumbling about this, asked them, "Does this cause you to stumble in your faith?"

⁶²What if you would see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before? ⁶³The Spirit is the one who gives life. The flesh does not help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and they are life.

⁶⁴But there are some of you who do not believe." For Jesus knew

from the beginning those who would not believe and the one who would betray him. ⁶⁵He said, “This is why I told you that no one can come to me, unless it is given to him by my Father.”

⁶⁶After this, many of his disciples turned back and were not walking with him anymore. ⁶⁷So Jesus asked the Twelve, “You do not want to leave too, do you?”

⁶⁸Simon Peter answered him, “Lord, to whom will we go? You have the words of eternal life. ⁶⁹We have come to believe and know that you are the Holy One of God.”

Sermon

Through Moses and Aaron, God teaches us that people will only hear what they want to hear, even in the face of the miraculous power of God. Pharaoh demanded a miracle and God gave him one. Pharaoh refused to listen. He called on his wise men and sorcerers to duplicate the power of God. Satan gave it his best shot, but his works were eaten by God's. And Pharaoh's heart became hard.

The display of God's power, whether it is in nature or in an extraordinary miracle, does not create faith. Only the Word of God can do that.

We pray that God would open our hearts to hear and to believe his holy word.

⁸The LORD said to Moses and to Aaron, ⁹“When Pharaoh says to you, ‘Give us a warning sign,’ then you are to tell Aaron, ‘Take your staff and throw it down in front of Pharaoh, and it will become a snake.’”

¹⁰Then Moses and Aaron went to Pharaoh. They did just as the LORD had commanded. Aaron threw down his staff in front of Pharaoh and his officials, and it became a snake. ¹¹But then Pharaoh also called for his wise men and sorcerers. Those magicians of Egypt did the same thing by their occult practices. ¹²They each threw down
