Old Testament Lesson

Our Old Testament Lesson displays the confidence of God's people. There is no greater power than God. The world can rage and fight. Satan can deceive and destroy. But Jesus came to save.

Shadrak, Meshak, and Abednego knew God's protection under persecution. Even faced with the threat of an agonizing death by fire, they remained faithful. "Our God is able to save us... But if he does not, you should know that we will not serve your gods, and we will not worship the golden statue that you set up." God went with them into the fire and kept them safe.

Luther experienced it, too. Persecution continues to this day. Generations of Lutherans have put their confidence is in God alone. We are saved by faith alone. We come to faith by Scripture alone. We have forgiveness by grace alone. Even though we walk through the valley of the shadow of death, we fear no evil, for God is with us.

Daniel 3:16-28 (EHV)

¹⁶Shadrak, Meshak, and Abednego answered King Nebuchadnezzar, "We have no need to answer you about this matter. ¹⁷Since our God, whom we serve, does exist, he is able to save us from the blazing fiery furnace. So, he may save us from your hand, Your Majesty. ¹⁸But if he does not, you should know, Your Majesty, that we will not serve your gods, and we will not worship the golden statue that you set up."

¹⁹Then Nebuchadnezzar was filled with rage, and the expression on his face changed against Shadrak, Meshak, and Abednego. He said to heat the furnace seven times hotter than it was usually heated. ²⁰He ordered some men, who were soldiers from his army, to bind Shadrak, Meshak, and Abednego in order to throw them into the blazing fiery furnace. ²¹So these men were bound in their coats, their pants, their

turbans, and their other clothing, and they were thrown into the middle of the blazing fiery furnace. ²²Because the king's order was urgent and the furnace was extremely hot, those men who carried Shadrak, Meshak, and Abednego were killed by the intense heat of the fire. ²³But these three men, Shadrak, Meshak, and Abednego, who had been tied up, fell into the blazing fiery furnace.

²⁴Then King Nebuchadnezzar was startled and immediately stood up. He said to his advisors, "Didn't we throw three men, who had been tied up, into the middle of the fire?"

They answered the king, "Certainly, Your Majesty."

²⁵He said, "Look! I see four men, who are untied and walking around in the middle of the fire, unharmed. What is more, the appearance of the fourth is like a son of the gods."

²⁶Then Nebuchadnezzar approached the door of the blazing fiery furnace. He said, "Shadrak, Meshak, and Abednego, servants of the Most High God, come out!" Then Shadrak, Meshak, and Abednego came out from the middle of the furnace. ²⁷The satraps, the prefects, the governors, and the royal advisors gathered together and looked at these men. The fire had no power over their bodies. Not a hair on their head was singed, their robes were not damaged, and the smell of fire had not stuck to them.

²⁸Nebuchadnezzar said, "Blessed be the God of Shadrak, Meshak, and Abednego, who sent his angel and saved his servants, who trusted in God and ignored the king's command. They gave up their bodies and did not pay homage or worship any god except their God."

Epistle Lesson

Our Epistle lesson was used at Luther's funeral. It declares the power and the glory of the Gospel. God uses people to proclaim his saving word to every person on the earth. In the Old Testament, he used the prophets. In the New, he used the apostles. In the Reformation, he used Luther. Now he uses us.

God's messengers give Him glory. We prepare people for Christ's return. We lead people to worship our Creator, our Redeemer, and our Sanctifier. Gospel Lesson

God's Word is a refuge and a fortress in a world filled with violence and hatred. Each deception, each natural disaster, each country torn by war, drives us to our only source of hope: Our Savior Jesus Christ. God's people are ridiculed, persecuted, and rejected. But even in the face of discrimination, God uses us to bring light and salvation to people heading for destruction. His Word is powerful—through it the Holy Spirit reaches into the lives of condemned sinners and brings forgiveness and eternal life.

What a privilege to bring the power of God into a lost and broken world. Jesus warns us that people will resist. They might even persecute us. But God will be with us, speaking through our words wherever he sends us.

Mark 13:5-11 (EHV)

⁵Jesus began by telling them, “Be careful that no one deceives you. ⁶Many will come in my name, saying, ‘I am he,’ and will deceive many.

⁷“Whenever you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be troubled. Such things must happen, but the end is not yet. ⁸In fact, nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be earthquakes in various places. There will be famines. These are the beginning of birth pains. ⁹But be on your guard! People will hand you over to councils, and you will be beaten in synagogues. You will stand in the presence of rulers and kings for my sake as a witness to them. ¹⁰And the gospel must first be preached to all the nations. ¹¹Whenever they arrest you and hand you over, do not worry beforehand what you should say.
