

Old Testament Lesson

What was the best day of your life? What was the worst? God's descriptions suggest that Judgment Day will be both. But not for everybody.

Anyone who stands without Jesus as their Savior will be terrified. They will look with horror at the perfect Judge, the Savior they decided they didn't need, coming to deliver punishment for their selfishness and the evil that lived in their hearts. There will be no place to hide. There will be no excuse. Justice will be complete and irrevocable. It will be the worst day ever.

But not for everybody.

Everyone standing in faith, cleansed through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, will be filled with overwhelming joy. Weariness will fall away. We will leap for joy in God's perfect justice. And Jesus is coming to set us free and to bring us home. It will be the best day ever!

Epistle Lesson

²⁴For Christ did not enter a handmade sanctuary, a representation of the true sanctuary. Instead, he entered into heaven itself, now to appear

before God on our behalf. ²⁵And he did not enter to offer himself many times, as the high priest enters the Most Holy Place year after year with blood that is not his own. ²⁶Otherwise he would have needed to suffer many times since the creation of the world. But now he has appeared once and for all, at the climax of the ages, in order to take away sin by the sacrifice of himself. ²⁷And, just as it is appointed for people to die only once and after this comes the judgment, ²⁸so also Christ was offered only once to take away the sins of many, and he will appear a second time—without sin—to bring salvation to those who are eagerly waiting for him.

Gospel Lesson & Sermon

When Jesus speaks every believer hears the voice of life. Jesus changes our fate from the judgment we deserve to the perfect life in heaven that he won for us on the cross. Only the Word of Christ has the power to breathe life into hearts cold and dead in sin. By the grace of God and by the power of the Holy Spirit, everyone who listens will live.

When Christ returns, he will enforce the will of his Father He will judge with perfect, final justice. Everyone in faith will rise to live. Those dead in sin and without their Savior will rise to face the condemnation their sins have earned.

John 5:19-30 (EHV)

¹⁹Jesus answered them directly, “Amen, Amen, I tell you: The Son can do nothing on his own, but only what he sees the Father doing. Indeed, the Son does exactly what the Father does. ²⁰For the Father loves the Son and shows him everything he is doing. And he will show him even greater works than these so that you will be amazed. ²¹For just as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, so also the Son gives life to those he wishes.

²²“In fact, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son, ²³so that all should honor the Son just as they honor the Father. Whoever does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent

him. ²⁴Amen, Amen, I tell you: Anyone who hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He is not going to come into judgment but has crossed over from death to life.

²⁵“Amen, Amen, I tell you: A time is coming and is here now when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who listen will live. ²⁶For just as the Father has life in himself, so also he has granted the Son to have life in himself. ²⁷And he has given him authority to execute judgment, because he is the Son of Man.

²⁸“Do not be amazed at this, for a time is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice ²⁹and will come out. Those who have done good will rise to live, but those who have practiced evil will rise to be condemned. ³⁰I can do nothing at all on my own. I judge only as I hear. And my judgment is just, for I do not seek my own will, but the will of him who sent me.
