Greetings from kindergarten and first grade,


November has been a very busy month. Kindergarten is busy beginning little reader books and blending sounds into words. We are so excited for reading!

2nd, 3rd, & 4th

5th, 6th, 7th, & 8th

Reading classes are finishing up *Caddie Woodlawn* by Carol Ryrie Brink or in the middle of *A Christmas Carol* by Charles Dickens. English classes are finishing up units about business letters or verbs. In science we are continuing to explore the properties of visible light and why objects appear to be the colors they are. In our activity, students explore mixing red, green, and blue light to create new colors. In the picture to the right, a student is looking through a spectroscope, which is a device that separates visible light into different colors. In PE, we are working on our hand-eye coordination by juggling with balls and scarves!
