
2nd, 3rd, & 4th

August and September flew by! I cannot believe that we are already almost a quarter into the school year. Some highlights for the class have been our science experiments, where we learned about and tested the properties of materials, biographies read in 3rd and 4th grade, our 2nd grade field trip to the bank, and new skills learned in technology class. Mrs. Schmiege is teaching the students about geography in social studies, so they made balloons with the continents and oceans labeled. Mrs. Kamps worked with second grade on identifying sentence types, editing and rewriting sentences, and parts

of a sentence. Third and fourth graders learned sentence parts. Now they are identifying various ways nouns are used in sentences.

October will bring a jump rope unit for P.E., a field trip to Moana, new books for reading class, and more Bible stories and songs to learn and love. The students are gradually becoming more and more responsible. We will continue to work on keeping track of our assignments.

We learn about facing our fears on the climber, challenging ourselves, and helping friends.

Kindergarten & 1st



We have been very busy in kindergarten and first grade! So far we have learned our color words, four sight words, and what makes up a complete sentence. First grade is working on different kinds of sentences and knowing what ending mark is appropriate for each.

We had so much fun learning about the lifecycle of a monarch butterfly. Thanks to Helen and Henri for finding caterpillars for our class. We all really enjoyed watching them emerge from their chrysalis. We were very excited to learn how to tell a boy and girl butterfly apart.

We also explored turning primary colors into secondary colors. Each student enjoyed color mixing and discovering first hand what colors they can create from primary colors. In Spanish we are learning how to say the Color words in Spanish too!

In science we learned about animals and the amazing skills and abilities God gave them. We learned about camouflage and other amazing things! We hid moths around the classroom to practice our camouflage skills and learned why God created birds with different beaks. We are having so much fun in science!

5th, 6th, 7th, & 8th

Here in the upper grade we have been busy adjusting to life with a brand new teacher. The 5th-6th graders have finished their first book in reading class and have moved on to a new one *The Tales of Despereaux*. 7th and 8th have a new book as well in *Maniac Magee*. We are also just about to complete our first major writing paper on vivid descriptions.

For English class, the students have settled into the daily class routine. Students are learning functions and correct usage of nouns and pronouns in sentences.





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
